

Marcus Urann Scholarship

Background on Scholarship:

The Marcus Urann Scholarship was established to provide financial assistance for education beyond the secondary level to the children of cranberry growers operating cranberry bogs and adjacent acreage in Massachusetts and to the children of their employees residing in Massachusetts, when a financial need for such assistance can be demonstrated. Bank of America, N.A., serves as Trustee. Award winners will need to reapply each year to qualify.

Qualifications for the Marcus Urann Scholarship are as follows:

1. Must be a child of a cranberry bog owner or a cranberry bog employee residing in Massachusetts, who plans to pursue an education beyond the secondary school level.
2. Must demonstrate financial need.

1. Completed application.
2. Copy of high school / college transcript.
3. Two letters of recommendation.
4. Most recent FAFSA and Tax Return.
