3. Submit a narrative or presentation that effectively communicates the Applicant's suitability for this scholarship. Acceptable formats include, a written essay, electronic media presentation, graphic presentation, etc. Essays shall be 350-750 words; media presentations shall be three to five minutes in length; graphic presentations shall be no more than six slides or pages.
